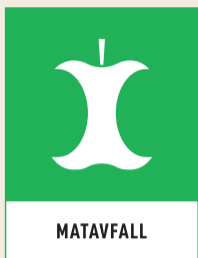

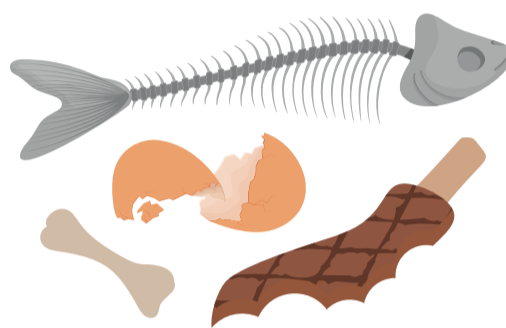
From January 1st, 2024

Yes – this is food waste



- bread
- pasta and rice
- fruit and vegetables



- meat and meat bones
- fish and seafood
- eggshells



- candy (no paper)
- tea leaves and bags
- coffee grounds and filter
- paper towels



No – this is general waste



- flowers and potted plants
- herb and salad pots
- popsicle sticks
- chewing gum
- nicotine pouches and cigarettes



- plastic bags
- colored napkins
- wet wipes and tissues
- cotton swab and plasters
- diapers, tampons and pads



- vacuum cleaner bags
- candles
- ashes
- cat litter
- animal waste

TIPS AND TRICKS!

We've got some tips so you can avoid dripping bags in the bag holder.

- **Bag holder** – use the bag holder from SEOM to minimize bad smells and dripping.
- **Keep the bag dry** – before putting the food waste in the bag, let it get dry in the sink.
- **New bag** – change bag at least every third day to keep it fresh.
